MEMBERSHIP POLICIES

PRIVATE OWNERSHIP & STEWARDSHIP

Union Country Club is privately owned and operated. Ownership and Club Management establish policies and programming with long-term stewardship in mind—preserving our golf heritage while thoughtfully enhancing the experiences that serve the entire membership.

MEMBERSHIP TERM & RENEWAL

Membership runs on an annual basis starting April 1 and will automatically renew unless you notify us otherwise. You have the entire month of April to inform us if you decide to cancel your membership. Please note that you are responsible for any charges incurred until that time. If we do not receive your cancellation notice by April 30th, we will assume you wish to continue your membership.

Membership fees are non-refundable and non-prorated.

DUES & BILLING

Dues may be paid annually or through the approved monthly payment structure. Statements are issued electronically and are due upon receipt.

Each membership is assigned a unique account. Members are responsible for all charges incurred under their account, including those made by authorized family members and registered guests.

To ensure billing accuracy, members are asked to confirm their account information at the time of purchase and to review their monthly statement promptly.

If a billing discrepancy is identified, members must notify the Club within thirty (30) days of statement issuance so that it may be reviewed in a timely manner. After this period, charges will be considered accurate and accepted.

Returned checks, declined payments, or failed electronic transactions may be subject to administrative fees and reinstatement charges.

The Club reserves the right to require verification of identity for account charges when necessary to maintain billing integrity.

Any account balance remaining unpaid beyond 30 days may be subject to interest charges. Accounts not settled within the club's established payment terms may result in the suspension of charging privileges and/or membership access until the account is brought current.



MEMBERSHIP POLICIES CONTINUED

PAYMENT AUTHORIZATION & AUTOMATIC BILLING

A valid payment method is required for all memberships.

Membership dues and applicable charges are automatically processed on the Club's established billing cycle using the payment method on file.

Members may authorize payment via credit card or ACH transfer. A 3% processing fee will be applied to all credit card transactions. Members are encouraged to enroll in ACH payments to avoid processing fees.

Members are responsible for maintaining accurate and current payment information, including monitoring expiration dates and account changes.

If a payment is declined, expired, or otherwise unsuccessful, the member will be notified and required to provide updated payment information promptly. Declined payments may be subject to administrative fees and may result in suspension of Club privileges until the account is brought current.

The Club reserves the right to process outstanding balances using the authorized payment method on file.



CLUB ETIQUETTE & SHARED USE GUIDELINES

DRESS GUIDELINES

The **Grille Room (April-September)** operates as a relaxed dining space during the summer season. Golf attire, athletic wear, and casual summer clothing are welcome. We simply ask that attire be clean, dry, and presentable.

The following are not permitted inside the Clubhouse:

- Uncovered swimwear
- Bare feet
- Wet clothing
- Excessively revealing attire

Shoes are required at all times for all dining spaces.

The **1911 Bistro (October-March)** offers a more refined dining atmosphere during the fall and winter season. Golf attire and casual clothing remain acceptable; however, members and guests are encouraged to dress in a manner consistent with an elevated dining environment.

RESPECT FOR FELLOW MEMBERS

The Club serves golfers, families, social members, and guests alike. Courtesy and awareness of others help maintain an atmosphere where all members feel comfortable and valued. Members are encouraged to be mindful of noise levels, shared seating areas, and the intended use of each space.

RESPECT FOR STAFF

Our team works diligently to provide professional service and maintain the quality of the Club. Members and guests are expected to treat all staff with courtesy and professionalism. Questions, concerns, or special requests should be directed to Club Management rather than operational staff working in kitchens, service stations, or restricted areas.

EMPLOYEE-ONLY AREAS

Kitchens, service stations, storage rooms, administrative offices, and other marked operational areas are restricted to staff for safety and insurance purposes. Members and guests should not access these areas at any time.

STEWARDSHIP OF THE CLUB

Union Country Club has served this community for more than a century. As members, we share in the responsibility of preserving its traditions, facilities, and welcoming spirit for future generations. Courtesy, awareness, and respect for shared spaces ensure that every member—golfer, family, and guest alike—enjoy the Club fully.



MEMBER EVENT POLICIES & RESERVATION GUIDELINES

Union Country Club offers a variety of social gatherings, holiday dining experiences, specialty dinners, and member events throughout the year. Thoughtful planning ensures exceptional quality and service. The following guidelines help maintain that standard.

RESERVATIONS & RSVP DEADLINES

Many events require advance reservation by the stated RSVP deadline.

An RSVP confirms your intent to attend and allows the Club to finalize food purchases, staffing, and event preparation.

Reservations made after the deadline may be accommodated only if space and preparations allow.

MEMBER EVENT CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations received prior to the stated deadline will not incur charges.

Cancellations made after the deadline may be subject to full event pricing, as food and staffing commitments will have already been finalized.

LIMITED-SEATING & SPECIALTY EVENTS

Select events, including wine dinners, chef experiences, and curated programming, offer limited seating to preserve quality and atmosphere.

Registration for these events confirms attendance and financial commitment. Cancellations after the deadline will be charged in full.

PRIVATE EVENT SPACE USAGE

Club spaces reserved for private events may not be used or rearranged without prior approval from Management.

STEWARDSHIP OF PROGRAMMING

Accurate reservations allow the Club to maintain high-quality programming, responsibly manage resources, and continue offering diverse events that complement the golf tradition and serve the entire membership.

AUTOMATIC SERVICE CHARGE

When you dine or celebrate at UCC, a **20% service charge** will automatically be added to your total. This helps us ensure a competitive wage for our events and dining staff throughout the year. While additional tipping is not required, if you believe your service deserves extra recognition, you are more than welcome to do so! Please note that the service charge contributes to hourly wages and is not a direct tip for your servers.

POOL POLICIES

POOL CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

All members and guests must check in at the Pool Snack Shack upon arrival.

SUPERVISION & AGE REQUIREMENTS

- Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult while in the pool area.
- Lifeguards monitor pool safety but do not replace parental supervision.
- Children who are not strong swimmers should remain within arm's reach of a supervising adult and must wear appropriate flotation and safety equipment while at the pool.

SWIM DIAPER REQUIREMENT

All non-potty-trained children must wear approved swim diapers while in the pool. Regular diapers are not permitted. Failure to comply may result in removal from the pool area.

SANITATION & BIOLOGICAL INCIDENTS

In the event of a biological contamination incident requiring pool closure, draining, and cleaning, the responsible member will be charged for all associated service, chemical, and restoration costs.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

- Outside food, beverages, and coolers are not permitted in the pool area.
- Glass containers are strictly prohibited.
- Poolside food and beverage service is available for member convenience.

SAFETY STANDARDS

For the safety of all guests:

- Running on the pool deck is prohibited.
- Diving is permitted only in designated areas.
- Rough play or unsafe behavior is not permitted.
- Lifeguard and management instructions must be followed at all times.

Management reserves the right to suspend pool privileges for unsafe or repeated violations.

GUESTS

Guests may join pool activities when accompanied by a member for a fee of **\$10 per guest**, with a maximum of **6 guests per day**. It is the Member's responsibility to ensure the conduct and supervision of their guests at all times. All children age 25 and older will be charged a guest fee.

Please note that guests of members who are not participating in our annual Member Guest Tournament (from July 15 to July 18) are not permitted due to capacity limitations. We appreciate your understanding.

COURSE & PRO SHOP INFORMATION

BAG& CART STORAGE:

Bag storage is also included in your full golf membership. We will store your clubs in our secure bag room and keep your clubs clean for you. We will create a bag tag with your name on it and place it on your bag for reference. Please do not remove it as it helps our bag room personnel keep everyone's equipment organized.

Pull carts are allowed to be stored at the club for a fee of **\$75.00 per year**. We have limited space so please check availability for this option. This also includes the storage and charging of any motorized walking carts. The fee for these units is **\$275.00** for the year and is also based on space availability.

LOCKERS:

Lockers are included in your full golf membership. Please see **Mike Jones** our Locker room attendant or **Karl Hackle** (Assistant Golf Professional) to secure a locker for the season. We do ask that you provide your own lock for security.

SERVICES:

COURSE & PRO SHOP INFORMATION

GOLF CARTS:

Golf carts are available for rent for **4 holes (\$8)**, **9 holes (\$14)**, or **18 holes (\$24)**.

Each cart is equipped with a split windshield, bag cover for inclement weather, sand bottles for divot repair, a built-in cooler, and a USB charging port for phones or small devices.

We strongly encourage the use of the sand bottles to help maintain course conditions. If using a personal speaker, please be mindful of your surroundings and respectful of fellow players on the course.

PIN PLACEMENTS:

Pin placements usually change daily. There are pin charts on your carts designating the location on each hole, i.e., today we are on pin placement 2. Look at your chart and find the hole you are playing. Look for number 2 on the green. This will tell you what location on the green the pin is placed. The information for what pin location we are on for the day will be located outside the golf shop on the information board.

PRACTICE FACILITY:

The practice range is stocked with balls for Full Golf Members. Please hit within the designated roped areas to help maintain the practice tee.

For the 2026 season, the practice tee will be mats only on Mondays and Tuesdays. The range follows the same hours as the Golf Shop, though it may close early twice per week in the spring for maintenance. Any schedule changes will be communicated via email.

Please do not remove range balls from the practice area for use on the course.

The putting green is always available, and we ask that chip shots remain on a low trajectory to protect the surface.



COURSE & PRO SHOP INFORMATION

TEE TIMES:

To ensure the best possible experience for you and your guests, we encourage members to reserve tee times in advance. Tee times can be booked through the UCC mobile app, online, or by calling the Golf Shop. While we do our best to accommodate walk-ins when possible, reserving a time allows our team to properly prepare and provide the highest level of service.

UCC also offers several regular playing groups that welcome member participation. Tuesday through Friday, a group of gentlemen typically gathers for play around 12:00 PM, with participation ranging from 8–24 players. On Saturdays and Sundays, the group meets at 10:00 AM. Teams are organized based on the number of players participating that day, creating a relaxed and friendly competitive atmosphere and a great opportunity to meet fellow members.

PERSONAL COURSE CARE:

We take great pride in the condition of our golf course and ask that all members help us maintain it. Please rake bunkers after use, sand divots on tees and fairways (do not sand divots in the rough), repair ball marks on the greens, and follow all cart signs and designated exits.

These simple courtesies help ensure excellent playing conditions for you, your fellow members, and your guests throughout the season.

COURSE & PRO SHOP INFORMATION

MEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION (MGA):

- The Men's Golf Association (MGA) offers full male golfers the opportunity to participate in a weekly game organized by the Golf Shop. An annual \$150 MGA fee is required and will be billed to your account at the beginning of the season.
- Each week's format will be posted on the information board outside the Golf Shop. Members must sign up in the Golf Shop prior to play and may participate while playing with their regular group, provided there is at least one playing partner or witness.
- All scores for the MGA Game of the Week are pulled directly from your USGA Handicap account, so scorecards are no longer required. Simply record your name and date of play on the sign-up sheet and ensure your hole-by-hole score is posted.
- Weekly results will be posted outside the Golf Shop and near the locker rooms, with winnings issued as Golf Shop credit.

WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION (WGA):

WGA stands for Women's Golf Association. The ladies run their tournament schedule independently and release their full schedule in early spring. The ladies play every Tuesday and Thursday morning between 8:30am and 9am. Feel free to contact the golf shop for more information about the WGA.

MEN'S THURSDAY NIGHT LEAGUE:

The Men's Thursday night league is a two-man league that plays every Thursday starting in April and runs through August. Currently, Brian Williams heads up the league. JUNIOR GOLF:

Junior golf is something we love and strive to incorporate in our growth of the game concepts. We provide individual lessons that are tailored to the youth's skill set. We also have Kids Clinics that begin in June. They are a series of 5 lessons that encompass the basics of the game, including course etiquette, swing dynamics, and short game proficiency. COURSE & PRO SHOP INFORMATION

GHIN:

GHIN is the operating system we use to produce a handicap for you to be able to play in club events at UCC and other courses. This service is included in your Full Golf Membership. This will allow the primary member to have a handicap for the season. In the event you would like to add on family members to this there will be a one-time charge for the year of \$45.00 per person added. Full details of how to set this up and use the GHIN App on your phone can be answered by one of the golf professionals in the Golf Pro Shop.

GUEST FEES:

Guest fees for non-family members will be \$85.00. Please notify the golf shop in advance to make tee times. Green fees for immediate family members will be \$65.00. You may bring the same guest up to twice per year if they live locally; unlimited if they reside outside the local area. Please contact Sean Kenily for more information.

HOLE-IN-ONE INSURANCE:

The Hole in One Insurance is in place to help the individual pay for the bar tab in the case of an ace. The bar tab will be covered up to \$1000 per hole in one. The initial \$1000 is covered by your contribution to the MGA fund at the start of the year. If a hole in one is recorded, all full golf members will be charged a \$5.00 fee to refund the account for the next hole in one. This money will always be used for funding this account only and benefit you and your guest. If a guest of a member happens to get the hole in one, the fund will be used under the member that is responsible for bringing the guest. In the case of a bar bill exceeding the \$1000 threshold the member will have the ability to cut the tab off or may continue to run the bill at their discretion and the difference will be the responsibility of the member to pay.

MEMBERSHIP STANDARDS

At Union Country Club, we offer a variety of membership options designed to meet the needs of our community. While each membership category includes unique benefits, several standards apply to all memberships:

FAMILY ELIGIBILITY

Membership benefits extend to the immediate family, including dependent children under age 25 who live at home and are enrolled in school full-time or serving on active military duty. For children of current members ages 25–30, please refer to our Legacy Membership options.

DUES STRUCTURE

Dues are based on the age of the oldest member on the account, regardless of whether they are listed as the primary or a dependent member.

BILLING & TAXES

A 6.75% tax rate is applied to all membership dues.

Annual dues must be paid in full by April 15 each year.

Monthly dues are billed April through September.

MEMBERSHIP TERM

All memberships require a one-year commitment running from April 1 to March 31.

Membership fees are non-refundable and are not prorated.
